

## Post procedure instructions

## Immediately following procedure:

- Apply cool compress to the treated area for 10 to 20 minutes. Reduces the swelling and aids in healing.
- Apply A and D ointment for the next seven days with a clean cotton swab, do not use your fingertips. Morning and evening if preferred.
- Keep the procedure area moist with ointment to retain the desired color.

## Day 2-3 and on until healed

- Gently cleanse the procedure area. You may rinse with warm water and lightly pat area dry. Do not expose treated area to full pressure of the water in the shower.
- Eyeliner procedure use A and D sparingly taking care not to clog the tear duct.
- Do not apply topical make up over the area for a minimum of three days.
- Do not rub or pick at the epithelial Crust, allow it to flake off on its own.
- Absolutely no scrubbing, no chemicals (glycolic peels, retinol, Retin a)
- · No sauna or steam room.
- Do not soak treated area in the bath, swimming pool or hot tub.
- Do not swim in fresh, salt or chlorinated pool water.
- Do not expose the treated area to the sun or tanning bed.
- Do not use mascara or eyelash curler (clean with alcohol) for two days
  post procedure and when you resume to use it purchase a new tube, the
  old tube may have bacteria in it.
- Area may be red and slightly swollen and have tightness. As healing begins it will be itchy, do not scratch the area apply A&D when necessary.

Failure to follow post treatment instructions may cause the loss of pigment, discoloration or infection. Remember colors appear brighter and darker more sharply defined immediately following the procedure. As the healing progresses color will soften.

A touchup procedure will be necessary. Touchup cost is \$75. Any touchups past your first are \$150 within the first year. Final results cannot be determined until healing is complete.
